

## Jesus Heals a Blind Man

[a CedarS Bible Re-enactment script by Lauren & Warren]

**Bible Verse:** John 9:1-7, with insights inspired by B. Cobbey Crisler's commentary in *Book of John, A Walk with the Beloved Disciple* (p. 52-53)

### Characters:

- Jesus
- Disciples
- Blind Man
- Narrator

**Narrator:** Jesus and his disciples were passing by in Jerusalem when they saw a man who had been blind since his birth. The disciples turned to Jesus and asked him what sounded like a multiple choice quiz:

**Disciple:** Master, who sinned here, (A) the man, or (B) his parents, that he was born blind?

**Jesus:** The answer is (C) None of the above. And (D) DNA (Does Not Apply.) No one sinned, not his parents, and certainly not the blind man. This is a wonderful way for God's works to be manifested through healing. I carry out the works of God, just as I am teaching you to do them as well. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

**Narrator:** When he finished saying this he spat on the ground showing his contempt for the supposed dust origin of man as first misstated in Gen. 2:6 & 7. He then made clay out of that muddy mixture and placed it on the blind man's eyes, thereby indicating that a supposed material or dust origin was the true cause of his blindness that needed to be washed off in a baptism of immersion in his nativity in Spirit.

**Jesus:** Go to the pool of Siloam and wash off every trace of the dust man,

**Narrator:** The blind man, with mud all over his face, can't see his way to the pool, but somehow makes it there, washes, and comes out seeing!

### Follow-Up Questions:

- What traces of a supposed dust man origin need to be totally washed away from your eyes and experience? Can you encourage others, like Jesus did, to cleanse their thought of all sense of material origin? ("The foundation of mortal discord is a false sense of man's origin. To begin rightly is to end rightly. ..." S&H 262:27)
- Do circumstances ever argued to you that there are 1 or 2 supposed material causes for a problem when you really need to reply back "None of the above are true; and such DNA, simply Does Not Apply? (Since "Spiritual causation is the one question to be considered..." S&H 170:22)
- What did Jesus mean when he said 'I am the light of the world'? How are we also a light of the world?
- Do you have any examples of being a light? How can we inspire others to be a light of the world?
