Founded in 1962 by Ruth E. Huff, The CedarS Camps is a not-for-profit organization serving Christian Science youth. From its humble beginnings of just one cabin for girls and one cabin for boys, the camp now serves over 1,000 guests each year. The camp is backed by a volunteer Board of Trustees and is run by 2nd and 3rd generation members of its founding family, the Huffs.

At every testimony meeting, you'll see a long line of campers and staff waiting to share how they are practicing and demonstrating the Science of Christianity. Throughout the year, we receive letters of gratitude describing healings from camp—joy restored, purpose found, confidence gained, fears destroyed, sickness healed, physical limitations overcome, and character transformed!

CHRISTIAN SCIENCE PRACTICE

All programs include daily Bible Lesson study, metaphysical meetings ("mets") before activities, Sunday School, Wednesday testimony meetings, hymn sings, daily talks by the resident Christian Science practitioner, and support of Christian Science nurses.

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

CedarS offers over 20 summer programs with the aim of engaging the broad interests and God-given talents of today's Sunday School students. These range from general camp programs to specialty camps in horseback riding, sports, musical theater, engineering, and more. We also offer programs for families and adults. In the Fall, we open camp to Bible Study, Christian Science nursing retreats, CSO summits, and outreach.





TRAINING TO SERVE THE CAUSE

Counselors frequently say that CedarS prepared them to parent, teach Sunday School, serve church, and be healers in today's world. Writes one counselor alumni, "I credit my six-year experience as a counselor at CedarS for giving me strong résumé points to use on graduate school applications, problem-solving confidence that helped me succeed in a top-level doctoral program, and the courage to leave an academic position at a major university to enter the full-time practice of Christian Science."

BEAUTIFUL LANDSCAPE

The camp is situated in beautiful Ozark
Hill Country with spring-fed streams
for canoeing and fishing, lakes for
skiing and paddling, and wooded
hilltops for trail riding.

EXCELLENT FACILITIES

Our 1,000+ acre campground includes a Bible Lands Park, Sports Center, cable watersports park, covered riding arena, waterslide, ziplines, screened-in cabins with their own bathrooms, ski school boats, and more. To maintain our facilities and programs in top condition requires an annual commitment of approximately \$1 million.

HELP US GROW A SUSTAINABLE ENDOWMENT


Over the years, generous gifts from CedarS alumni and friends have allowed the CedarS Endowment Fund to grow to \$3.2 million. Income from this fund helps us meet our annual expenses, covering about 6% of the \$2.5 million that it takes to run our programs, pay our staff, and maintain our facilities.

But that means we must raise the remaining 94% of our annual expenses year after year through a combination of tuition and contributions, requiring a lot of fundraising to cover each year's costs. As a not-for-profit organization with a very small administrative staff, we have always chosen to allocate donations to serving campers and programs directly rather than to salaries for professional fundraising staff.


A \$20 MILLION ENDOWMENT WILL GENERATE THE \$1 MILLION REQUIRED ANNUALLY TO PROVIDE WELL-MAINTAINED FACILITIES AND ROBUST PROGRAMS FOR OUR YOUTH—THE FUTURE OF THE MOVEMENT.
