## Lesson Books

- The Bible & *Science Health with Key to the Scriptures* by Mary Baker Eddy with markers, if possible
- C.S. Quarterly Bible Lessons
- Bible Lesson print-out (optional)

## Modest Clothing

- 4 T-shirts that cover the midriff and underwear
- 3-5 pairs of shorts
- 1-2 pairs of jeans or long pants
- 4-5 pairs of underwear
- 4-5 pairs of socks
- 2 pairs of closed-toed shoes, expect at least 1 to get wet and muddy, especially if caving
- 1 pair of flip-flops or slide shoes for in the shower and cabin
- Riding boots or hard-soled shoes with ½” heels to keep foot from slipping through stirrups. *Optional: you may borrow boots from the corral.*
- Pajamas or nightgown, one for cooler evenings
- 2 swimming suits for pool & lake use: at least 1 one-piece for girls (second suit could be a secure tankini that covers *entire* midriff); no racing briefs/ Speedos for boys. Modest, please.
- 1 swim shirt or “rash guard”
- 1 raincoat or poncho and optional rain boots
- 1 sweatshirt\* and/or warm jacket
- 1 pair sweatpants\*

## Toiletries

- Comb and brush, shampoo/conditioner
- Toothbrush and paste
- Soap, soap container, deodorant
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray

## Linens for those staying cabins

*(A linen set can be rented for \$15 if needed – please pre-order through your registration.)*

- 2 sheets (top and bottom) for a single bed
- 1 pillow and case
- 1 warm blanket or sleeping bag *(Sleeping bags may be rented for \$7)*
- 1-2 towels and washcloths
- Beach towel for cable ski, kayak, etc.

## Optional

- Book to read
- Sun visor/ hat\*
- Sunglasses\*

## Miscellaneous

- Water bottle\*
- Flashlight & extra batteries\*
- 1-4 Ziplock bag(s) for wet items
- 1-2 Face masks (optional, unless required at any point by the local health department)\*

## Bring at Your Own Risk

- Musical Instruments & sports equipment
- Electronics

These items may be stored in climate controlled safe storage during your visit. Talk to the office staff upon check-in.

## Prohibited Items

Gum, pets, graffiti, weapons, pornography, alcohol, cigarettes, e-cigs, juuls/vaping devices, and drugs of any form.
